## "Drone" Registration

Have you ever had someone ask for your advice or feedback and then have them ignore it completely? Well, that's how the AMA feels right about now.

You have received communication from the AMA, you have seen it in the news, and straight out of left field here comes FAA "drone" registration. Obviously, the perception of this is negative, so I will stick to the highlights:

"Drone" Registration is being mandated by the FAA. It has started already, on December 21, 2015. Basically anything we fly at the field with the exception of those mini foamies would require pilot registration. The FAA is offering a credit of the \$5 registration fee if you register by January 21.

The FAA claims to be able to enforce this rule with penalties of tens to hundreds of thousands of dollars as well as prison time.

FAA has issued a deadline of February 19, 2016 to register if you operated a "drone" prior to December 21. I don't quite get that: So is that if you ever flew a model in your life prior to

December 21?

The AMA is asking members to hold off on registration, as if a second wind of negotiations will change things. The AMA must also be



asking you to hold off on flying until then and also forget about the \$5 credit.

If you do choose to register and not hold out, do so before January 21 to get that \$5 back.

Beware of fake drone registration sites. If you google "drone registration," there will be some unofficial sites in the top results. Only use the site if it is from faa.gov: www.faa.gov/uas/registration.

If you are unable to use the online form, the FAA has provided a phone number for assistance: 844-244-3565.
