Proposed Rule Change

FPV Spotters

A few years ago, we modified our Field Rules to support FPV (First Person View) flying with goggles. Additionally, FPV pilots must follow the AMA rules for FPV. See the following document:

The AMA has a rules that states: "All FPV flights require an AMA FPV pilot to have an AMA FPV spotter next to him/her maintaining VLOS with the FPV sUAS throughout its flight."

One of our field rules does not fully sync up with the AMA rule. Therefore it was proposed in the June meeting to change Field Rule #37 from:

"A spotter is encouraged always."

to:

"A spotter is always encouraged while flying. All FPV flights require an AMA FPV pilot to have an AMA FPV spotter next to him/her maintaining VLOS with the FPV sUAS throughout its flight"
